The Workshop consists of two blocks: a theoretical part and a practical part, which is the solution of case tasks by participants in small groups (2-3 people).

During the Workshop, participants will learn:

- what is emotional intelligence and what components does it consist of?
- why is emotional intelligence needed in digital communication?
- how does emotional intelligence manifest itself in the digital educational environment (based on a major research study in 2021)?
- what should be done to develop emotional intelligence (specific methods, technologies)?

During the master class, participants will be able to:

- in practice, check and compare whether the means of expression of emotions differ between teachers and students and does this affect the interpretation of digital means of expression of emotions?
- recreate the situation of remote communication between the teacher and the student and trace the entire mechanism of emotional interaction in order to find possible distortions and ways to overcome them;
- receive and master in practice specific exercises and techniques for developing emotional intelligence and controlling emotional states.
